



VOLUNTEER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

As At 20 February 2017

Subject to Change determined by conditions on the day

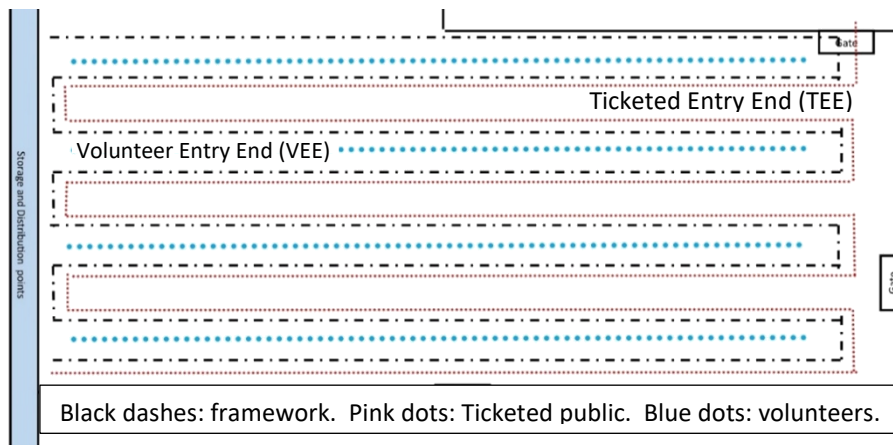
All volunteering will be carried out at Callendar Park with the exception of the ingredient preparation which will be at Innisfail State College.

The three fields that make up Callendar Park will be colour coded.

Field 1 – Blue, Field 2 – Red, Field 3 – Green

The framework will zigzag across the fields in runs with a Ticketed Entry End (TEE) and a Volunteer Entry End (VEE). These MUST REMAIN quite separate. The Volunteer ends are the entry point for the delivery of ingredients.

All runs will be numbered at the TEE end with schools allocated to particular runs. VEE ends will be identified by letters.



There are a variety of volunteering roles during the Banana Split World Record Attempt and these are outlined below. Some details cannot be finalized until just prior or during the attempt, so a degree of flexibility will be required, as will being attentive to PA calls. Refreshments will be provided throughout the day and there may also be alternate refreshments available for purchase also. Please select carefully where you think you would be most suited to assist and tick accordingly on the application form. This page should be kept for your own information :

- 1. Full day from 6:00am to finish
This will include setting up the cardboard framework towers and channeling in the morning, taking a break around midday and returning to either usher or distribute ingredients – this will depend on the number of volunteers in each category
- 2. Half day commencing 6:00am to midday
This will involve setting up the cardboard framework towers and channeling. May also involve some unloading of trucks. The timings will be given to you during briefings.
- 3. Half Day commencing midday to finish
This will involve passing out of ingredients, collecting banana skins and loading into trucks for removal. The timing of this will be given to you during briefing. Will also include collecting any rubbish, assisting with dismantling framework. Some framework will be collected by the artists. This should be clearly indicated on checksheets and the towers
- 4. Prepared to act as usher for participants into ground (2 – 4:00pm)
This will involve ushering ticket holders to the correct runs if they are connected with a particular school. Or ushering to runs so that ticket holders are evenly dispersed across all the runs. Ushers will be needed at all gates and along runs. Full details will be given during briefings
- 5. Fruit / ingredient preparation at Innisfail State College
This will involve cutting up fruit which will in turn go on top of the banana split. This will happen under the supervision of a suitably qualified food safety supervisor, as required by Guinness World Records.

The day requires different jobs that need to be carried out. The various roles are clearly stated in the attached Terms & Conditions.

Those wishing to volunteer in the active roles: 1, 2 & 3 below will need to have a reasonable level fitness and stamina. Volunteers will also be required for cutting up fruit and preparing other ingredients on the day. Refreshments will be provided throughout the day. Hats and some sunscreen will also be provided. BYO water bottle and please be sun safe.
