Innisfail's Got Talent is a new event within the Feast of the Senses Festival. It will be held in Canecutter Court (Edith Street between Fitzgerald Esplanade and Rankin St) on Saturday 30 March between midday and 5:00pm. Judges will be James Blundell, Briar Blundell and Becci Nethery. There will be a low stage of approx. 6 sq m under a marquee. A sound technician will be on hand to ensure you are able to achieve your best results. There is no cost to enter this competition.

You will need to complete the entry form, including any particular requirements you may have, which may or may not be allowed depending on the staging configuration. Please have the registration forms back to us by Friday 15 March.

Important: in completing this application form to be potentially selected for Innisfail's Got Talent you must comply with the Terms and be available on Saturday afternoon and, should you win, Saturday evening 30 March 2019.

Please do not apply unless you and, if applicable, your Act Members agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions and are available on that date.

You and your act members affirm that you:

1. are:
 - a. at least 18 years of age; or
 - b. under 18 years of age and understand that a parent or legal guardian must also attend with you;
2. will complete and submit the application form in full, either online or manually by the closing date of 15 March;
3. will be able to meet all other conditions for eligibility as detailed elsewhere in this application form or the Terms; and

1. You will have three minutes to perform your act as described in your application.
2. You will provide all props necessary.
3. You will provide all musical instruments (other than drums)
4. You will provide any information necessary to assist the sound engineer to assist you, ahead of the day.
5. You will need to be able to set up in a very short time frame. As a result, those with complicated stage sets may not be able to enter the competition.
6. You will be fully responsible for your own safety and those around you during Innisfail's Got Talent.
7. No acts considered dangerous by the Feast of the Senses or the judges will be allowed to proceed. This includes, but not limited to: use of fire, water, animals, climbing to heights, anything that may damage the marquee or staging in place.
8. In the event that you participate in any stage of the production of Innisfail's Got Talent you understand and agree that you will execute all waivers, release agreements and/or a separate Participant/Contestant Release as required by the Feast of the Senses and any of the judges of this competition
